Kerpen's 2007 Bernkasteler Bratenhofchen Riesling Eiswein smells of candied cherry and caramel apple. A very sweet palate presence of vanilla-laced confectionary fruit manages somehow to achieve lightness and lift without any obvious impression of citricity or brightness. This remarkably pure, long wine never becomes saccharine, and while its range of flavors is relatively narrow, it should be worth following the wine for at least a decade.

Site-typical cherry and lime scent Kerpen's 2006 Bernkasteler Bratenhofchen Riesling Spatlese. Lushly-textured and ripe, yet brightly refreshing and cooling in its citrus and mint, this displays a distinctly alkaline and slightly fusil aspect that suggest more evolution than most of the wines in this year's Kerpen collection. Despite a mere 8.5% alcohol, this is not overly sweet, but it is enormously expressive and impressively persistent. My intuition is that it will be best drunk on the early side, by which for this category I mean within 10-12 years.

Offering another instance of remarkable delicacy allied to richness and textural creaminess, this offers nut paste and baked apple through a long, refined finish in which the sweetness is supportive without drawing attention to its self. This should merit 15-20 years of care and attention.

Apple and grapefruit are accented by toasted nuts and apple pips on a satisfyingly juicy, subtly bitter palate, and the saline, stony, alkaline finish here offers a veritable mineral bath. This should be worth following for 6-8 years.

A product of relatively early picking, Kerpen's 2007 Graacher Himmelreich Riesling Kabinett feinherb leads with lemon and apricot, then offers a sappy, bright display of same on a refreshing palate, and finishes with considerable lift and refreshment (at 11% alcohol); a distinct sense of wet stone; and no appreciable sweetness. I suspect this will be worth revisiting over a 5-6 year period.

Kerpen's "one star" 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Spatlese offers the malt and toasted nuts that characterized his "no star" version, but here with baked rather than fresh apple, and a honeyed glaze. (There was only minimal botrytis in the fruit, Kerpen insists.) This displays flattering creaminess of texture, memorable lift, and a long, soothing finish incorporates an unusual prominence of brown spices for a wine from this site.

Very ripe pear, mango, lily, honeysuckle, and heliotrope memorably and sweetly inform the nose of Kerpen's 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Auslese. Taking the

creaminess of this vintage's Kerpen Spatlesen to the next level, this at the same time preserves juicy primary fruit and manages a lift and elegance one seldom encounters in an Auslese. The ethereal pear nectar and wafting floral perfume here fit the wine's style to a tee. As with the starred Spatlese, this exhibits considerable brown spice character in its long, terrifically refined and almost levitating finish. Lay this bottled bouquet away in your cellar and it will not wilt for at least the next 20 years.

Date, marzipan, brown spices, and white raisin inform the Kerpen "three star" 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Auslese\*\*\*, a wine whose ethereal aromatics persist on a delicate palate underlain by pure honey. A chewy phenolic suggestion of cherry skin and pungent citrus zest add invigoration to the finishing richness of honey and white raisin. What's been left behind at this stage of botrytization is any real sense of refreshment. But it's early days for a wine that really deserves a decade in the cellar and should reward three.

The Kerpen 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Auslese feinherb is far and away the most impressive of this year's dry-tasting Kerpen wines. A greenhouse-like aura of flowers and greenery, along with almond, lemon and apple scent the nose. Combining flattering creaminess of texture, ample stuffing, and wet stone and alkaline mineral undertones with a considerable sense of sheer refreshment, this finishes with impeccable balance at 32 grams of residual sugar, despite which sweetness simply never becomes an issue. "This just stopped that way," says Kerpen. "It was supposed to become somewhat drier, but when a wine doesn't want to go any further, you shouldn't torment it." Amen! Let this one treat you over the next 10-12 years minimum.

A yeasty fermentative veil over the glass of Kerpen 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Beerenauslese parts to reveal ethereal notes of apple in the manner of Normandy cider. Hints of butterscotch in the nose become more prominent on the palate. This is overtly sweet even when compared with this year's Eiswein, much less with the rest of the present collection. Kerpen thinks it will clarify and become better-balanced in a couple of years. I suspect a much slower evolution, and that it will scarcely be worth "looking in on" and reassessing it for another half dozen years.

While I unfortunately missed out on a chance to taste its 2006 predecessor, Kerpen's 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Spatlese trocken Alte Reben – actually representing a cask-selection, although the vines are certainly old – may a few years to show its superiority over the corresponding “regular” bottling, which at the moment is somewhat more expressive and site-typical. In this “old vines” version, melon, almond, and hazelnut dominate in the nose and on a flatteringly silken-textured palate, with subdued suggestions of wet stone underlying the wine's nutty finish.

Although the term “Grosses Gewachs” is associated with the VDP growers association (yet utilized by relatively few of that organization's Mosel members), a number of members of the so-called Bernkastler Ring adopted the term in 2006 and again this year to refer to ambitious dry-tasting Riesling bottlings. Kerpen's 2007 Graacher Domprobst Riesling Grosses Gewachs offers grapefruit zest and toasted nuts on the nose and a piquant palate. Impressively dense, this manages to avoid any sense of heaviness, heat, or harshness from its 13% alcohol, and finishes with imposing depth of nutty be worth following

for at least 5-6 years.

And as Kerpen has demonstrated again and again – most recently with a shimmering, mineral, impeccably-balanced “one star” 1990 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Auslese I tasted with him last summer – his wines can go the distance. Fresh lime, lemon, and apple are the principle themes on the nose and palate of Kerpen's well-stuffed 2007 Wehlener Sonnenuhr Riesling Spatlese trocken. Cooling herbal notes in the finish help add a sense of refreshment; 12.5% alcohol acts like 11.5%; and the wine's palpable sense of extract does not preclude a sense of lift in the finish. This should perform well for at least 4-5 years.
